Responsibilities:

- Teaches independent living skills, social skills, vocational skills, or other related subjects, to HIPsters at My Possibilities.
- Writes lesson plans that meet the requirements of our curriculum template and directly relate to our Pillars of Instruction.
- Assists HIPsters during recreational activities, physical exercises, therapeutic activities and any other activity that may require slight additional assistance.
- Lead groups of HIPsters into the community for projects and volunteer opportunities.
- Responsible for upkeep on team goals and notes on a daily/weekly/monthly basis and must turn in all documents to the Billing and Contracts Specialist on time.
- Must adhere to all confidentiality guidelines of our HIPsters and their families.
- Acts as a role model and mentor to our HIPsters, working hard to keep a professional demeanor at all times.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in Special Education preferred.
- Experience working with adults with special needs a plus.
- Understands instruction methods including curriculum based instruction and the creation and implementation of lesson plans.
- Able to communicate effectively both verbally and in writing (sign language a plus).
- Personal qualities of integrity, credibility, with a commitment to and a passion for My Possibilities' mission.
- Must be able to lift 25lbs regularly and up to 50lbs occasionally.
- Must be able to demonstrate competency in social skills and leadership.
- CPR/First Aid certification required.
- Current driver's license, acceptable driving record and valid car insurance required.
